1	WHEREAS, The Indian Health Service has recommended in the "Indian Health Service
2	Area/Program Office Organizational Structure Review" dated October 1984.
3	That the IHS Tucson Program Area health care delivery system be trans-
4	ferred to the Phoenix Area Office, and
5	WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has in it's resolution 22-83 of February 17, 1983
6	opposed as similar recommendation to dismantel the Office of Research
7	and Development (ORD), which would have moved the Papago health care
8	delivery system to the Phoenix Area Office and
9	WHEREAS, The most recent recommendation is in direct violation of the original
10	resolution of the Papago Tribal Council, Resolution No. 14-68 of April
11	19, 1968 which establish the cooperative relationship between the
12	Papago Tribe and the IHS, and
13	WHEREAS, The IHS has not consulted with the Papago Tribe and the Office of
14	Research and Development in this latest recommendation to alter the
15	status of the established relationship with ORD,
16	WHEREAS, The Director of Indian Health Service, Dr. Everett Rhoades, may adopt
17	this recommendation,
18	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby repeat its
19	opposition to any reorganization of the Office of Research and
20	Development which would transfer the direct health care delivery
21	system, management and administrative functions which is presently
22	provided to the Papago Tribe by ORD to the Phoenix Area, or any other
23	area
24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby adopt the Tohono
25	O'otham Health Board's position paper as the official statement of the
26	Papago Tribe on the proposed reorganization of ORD.
27	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate officers and agents of the Papago
28	Tribe are hereby authorized and directed to deliver this Council's
29	decisions to the Director of Health and Human Services, the Director
30	of Indian Health Service and to the Arizona Congressional delegation,
31	and to do all things necessary or incidental to the purpose and intent
32	of this Resolution.

RES. NO. 13-85 (opposing Reorganization of ORD)

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 09th day of January, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 2 of <u>1,440.0</u> for; <u>-0-</u> against; <u>-0-</u> not voting; and <u>-0-</u> absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (h) 3 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1937, and approved 4 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject 5 to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
