EAS, The Papago Human Services department has the primary responsibility to provide for the care, treatment and welfare of children found to be of care:

EAS, Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 provides funds for development of child welfare programs under specified terms and conditions: and

EAS, The incidence of child abuse and neglect on the Papago Reservation is high and available therapeutic treatment approaches are ineffective;

EAS, The Papago Human Service department is capable of developing a culturally relevant program that will focus on relevant family therapy and parent effectiveness training; and

EAS, The need for such a program is well documented and Papago Human Services is capable of implementing the programs;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve the application of the Papago Human Service for Title II funds to develop and implement a culturally relevant Family Focus program which will decrease the incidents of child abuse and neglect through the use of a culturally relevant family therapy modality and parent effectiveness training program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any a thereto for the duration of the contracts.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of January, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) (f) of Article V of the 26 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
