

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Rescind Resolution No. 12-85)

RES. NO. 16-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council received a recommendation to re-invest certain
2 identified FY 84 savings and did so direct by Resolution No. 12-85;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by motion and resolution direct the Tribal
5 Administration to prepare a report to the Council on the costs and
6 reasons for the delay in the completion of HIP homes contracted by
7 the O'odham Construction company; and


8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council will upon receipt of the report and cost estimates
9 decide what funds, if any, will be committed to complete the HIP homes;

10 WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes the savings can be utilized for this
11 purpose;


12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Resolution 12-85 author-
13 izing the investment of \$760,700 of FY 84 savings is hereby rescinded,
14 and that the expenditure of such funds will be determined by the Papago
15 Council after the January 22nd Council Meeting in response to the report
16 on the HIP projects.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
18 day of January, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to
20 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) (a) of Article V
21 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, rati-
22 fied by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of
the Interior on January 16, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
