

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Tribal Council's Recommendation)

RES. NO. 17-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council was advised of the status and functions of O'odham
2 Construction Company; and

3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is dissatisfied with the status of the projects
4 contracted for by the O'odham Construction Company, particularly, the
5 HIP homes which were to have been completed by the Skill Center; and

6 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has expressed concern for those Papago people who
7 were selected to receive HIP homes but which are now at various in-
8 complete stages.


9 WHEREAS, It is the decision of the Papago Council to give specific directives
10 to the tribal officials to begin the process of determining what tasks
11 need to be completed, the costs, and by whom;

12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve
13 and direct the implementation of the following directives:

- 14 1. The Administration is directed, specifically Chairman, Vice-
15 Chairman, and Treasurer to get a detailed status on homes,
16 cost projection for completion, and notify O'odham contractors
17 to submit bids and report back to Council on January 22, and
18 to make attempts to recoup any contract monies from O'odham
19 Construction to put back into Account.
- 20 2. The Skill Center will terminate all work on HIP projects effective.
21 January 11, 1985.
- 22 3. An inventory of materials on hand for HIP Houses at O'odham
23 Construction be made and sold to individual O'odham contractors
24 for use.
- 25 4. Tribal officials' salaries are suspended until January 22, at
26 which time a review of the Council's directives will be made
27 to determine if officials have complied with such directives.
- 28 5. To continue agenda on January 22, 1985.

29 The forgoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day
30 of January, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
31 1,440.0 for -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the
32 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) (a) of Article V of
the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
