


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Authorization for disbursement of PIK funds)

RES. NO. 184-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did on March 10, 1983, file an Intention to Par-  
2 ticipate and Application for Payment with the U.S. Department of  
3 Agriculture under its Payment-in-kind ("PIK") Program, to which it  
4 agreed to devote approximately 120 acres of farm lands in the Chui  
5 Chu area to the conservation uses prescribed for such Program; and  
6 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe was awarded \$28,185.17 PIK funds as compensation for  
7 the acres devoted to such conservation uses; has expended \$3,600.00,  
8 costs incidental to the Tribe's participation in the Program; and  
9 holds the remainder of \$24,585.17, PIK Proceeds; and  
10 WHEREAS, Can file any claims for the PIK Proceeds have been made by the Sif  
11 Oidak District Council ("District Council"), by the Chui Chu Farmers  
12 Cooperative Association ("Association") and by assignees of standard  
13 land assignments issued under the Land Code of the Sif Oidak District,  
14 Ordinance No. 24 of the Papago Tribe ("Assignees"); and  
15 WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District Council did by Resolution No. 18-84 refer the  
16 matter to the Papago Council; and  
17 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the conflicting claims for the PIK  
18 Proceeds.  
19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
20 authorize and direct the disbursement of the PIK Proceeds in the  
21 control of the Papago Tribe in accordance with a written settlement  
22 agreed upon and signed by all three chairman's, i.e. the Sif Oidak  
23 District Council, The Association and The Assignees, or by their  
24 legal representatives, by which settlement they agree to indemnify  
25 each other and The Papago Tribe from any and all claims they or the  
26 individuals with whom they share or whom they represent may have or  
27 make on account of the disbursement or distribution of such PIK  
28 Proceeds.  
29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in the event a settlement has not been reached  
30 by these claimant's within two months of this date, such PIK Proceeds  
31 shall be paid into Tribal Courts with a request that it distribute  
32 same to the proper parties as their rights are determined by the  
Courts.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 19th  
2 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
3 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
4 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V  
5 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
6 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
7 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
8 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
9 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
10 the Papago Council.
