

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Amending "Schedule of Representatives to
District Councils" for Sells District)


1 WHEREAS, The Sells Community Council has filed an appeal, pursuant to Section
2 4 (b) of Article IV of the Uniform Election Ordinance, appealing the
3 number of representatives and alternates representing the Sells con-
4 stituency on the Sells District Council, claiming that the voting
5 constituency of Sells should be represented by eleven rather than the
6 seven representatives and alternates currently listed on the "Schedule
7 of Representatives to the District Councils"; and

8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has heard and considered the appeal and the evi-
9 dence presented by both the Sells Community Council and the Sells
10 District Council.


11 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the current "Schedule
12 of Representatives to the District Councils" be and it is hereby
13 amended to increase the number of representatives of the Sells
14 constituency on the Sells District Council from seven (7) to ten (10).

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 20th
16 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 687.5 for; 308.5 against; 444.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
18 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) of Article V
19 and by Article III of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
20 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
21 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
22 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
23 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
24 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
