6	WHEREAS,	The JOM Act was amended by the Indian Self-Determination and Education
7		Assistance Act of 1975, P. L. 93-638, to provide funds to meet the
8		unique and special needs of Indian children; and
9	WHEREAS,	The Papago Tribe has, since 1977, participated in the JOM program
10		receiving funds to meet the special needs of its children; and
11	WHEREAS,	The total elimination of the JOM program will affect 1,304 Papago
12		children and their families; and
13	WHEREAS,	The total elimination of the JOM program will mean the termination of
14		five (5) full time employees and three (3) part-time employees, who
15		now provide direct services to children under JOM guidelines;
16	WHEREAS,	No prior or meaningful consultation was conducted with the Papago
17	*	Tribe regarding the proposed elimination of the program and the
18		resultant adverse impact;
19	WHEREAS,	The Papago Tribe takes the position that the Bureau of Indian Affairs
20		is legally obligated to consult with and allow Indian Tribes meaningful
21		imput into a decision to terminate existing JOM programs and its
22		failure to do so is contrary to the policy statement issued by the
