


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Support of Johnson O'Malley Funding)

RES. NO. 190-85

- 1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised of proposed FY 86 funding re-  
2 ductions and/or terminations in many federal program, including the  
3 Johnson O'Malley (JOM) program;
- 4 WHEREAS, The JOM program has been in existence since April 16, 1934, providing  
5 support for the basic education of Indian students in public schools;
- 6 WHEREAS, The JOM Act was amended by the Indian Self-Determination and Education  
7 Assistance Act of 1975, P. L. 93-638, to provide funds to meet the  
8 unique and special needs of Indian children; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has, since 1977, participated in the JOM program  
10 receiving funds to meet the special needs of its children; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The total elimination of the JOM program will affect 1,304 Papago  
12 children and their families; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The total elimination of the JOM program will mean the termination of  
14 five (5) full time employees and three (3) part-time employees, who  
15 now provide direct services to children under JOM guidelines;
- 16 WHEREAS, No prior or meaningful consultation was conducted with the Papago  
17 Tribe regarding the proposed elimination of the program and the  
18 resultant adverse impact;
- 19 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe takes the position that the Bureau of Indian Affairs  
20 is legally obligated to consult with and allow Indian Tribes meaningful  
21 input into a decision to terminate existing JOM programs and its  
22 failure to do so is contrary to the policy statement issued by the  
23 Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs regarding the Bureau's mission  
24 statement.
- 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
26 strongly oppose the proposed elimination of the Johnson O'Malley  
27 program and urges the Honorable Congress to restore the JOM funding  
28 in full taking into consideration the needs of individual tribes  
29 presently benefitting from the program.
- 30 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 20th  
31 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
32 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the  
authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (f) and (h) of Article  
V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,

1 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
2 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
3 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
4 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
5 the Papago Council.
