

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Support of General Revenue Sharing Funding)

RES. NO. 191-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised of proposed FY 86 funding termi-
2 nations, reductions and/or freezes in many federal programs including
3 the General Revenue Sharing Program; and

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has benefitted directly under the General Revenue
5 Sharing Act qualifying to receive entitlements as a unit of local
6 government; and


7 WHEREAS, The funds received as revenue sharing funds have supplemented
8 essential and much needed services for the elderly, children and
9 dependent families in such key areas as housing improvement,
10 transportation and social services;

11 WHEREAS, The complete elimination of revenue sharing funds will have a direct
12 and strong adverse economic impact on the Tribal government as a
13 provider of services;


14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
15 strongly oppose the elimination of the General Revenue Sharing
16 Program and urges the Honorable Congress to restore such funding
17 as is necessary to continue the program at the FY 85 level.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 20th
19 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
21 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (f) and (h) of Article
22 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
23 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
