

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(FY 86 Law Enforcement Funds-Distribution Formula)


RES. NO. 192-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised of the proposed FY 86 budget of
2 law enforcement programs under the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
3 WHEREAS, The increase reflected in the proposed budget is a result of the
4 Congress authorizing an additional nine (9) million dollars in the
5 FY 85 budget which was added to bring all law enforcement programs at
6 least halfway to the "exemplary" level of funding; and
7 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs distributed the additional nine (9)
8 million in accordance with formula not reflective of the criteria
9 identified in the 1974/75 Task Force Analysis referenced by the
10 Congress in its decision to add the nine (9) million; and
11 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe did not receive adequate funds to bring the law
12 enforcement program at least halfway to the exemplary level partly
13 because of the distribution method; and
14 WHEREAS, Even if the Papago Tribe were to receive an additional amount of law
15 enforcement funds in accordance with the Bureau formula there would
16 still be insufficient funds to provide for the delivery of law
17 enforcement services because of the need for police vehicles;
18 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs is obligated to furnish the equipment
19 necessary to carry out the stated objectives of the law enforcement
20 program pursuant to 25 CFR 271.15, (c) and (1) and 271.24 (a) and (b);
21 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe had adequately documented a need for additional law
22 enforcement funds for personnel, program support and equipment because
23 of its population, land base, special circumstances and caseload;
24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
25 request the Honorable Congress to direct the Bureau of Indian Affairs
26 to distribute any future additional law enforcement funds in ac-
27 cordance with congressional directive to ensure fairness and equity
28 among all competing law enforcement programs and to furnish the
29 necessary equipment to carry out the objectives of the Law Enforcement
30 contract as required by law.

31 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 20th
32 day of March, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
1,211.5 for; 228.5 against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the

1 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (f) and (h) of Article
2 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
3 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
4 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
5 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
6 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
7 the Papago Council.
