

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Sells Reservation Water Study)

RES. NO. 19-85

1 WHEREAS, Section 303 (b) (a) of Title III of Public Law 97-293 (Southern Arizona  
2 Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982) reads as follows:

3 "In order to encourage the Papago Tribe to develop sources  
4 of water on the Sells Papago Reservation, the Secretary  
5 shall, if so requested by the Tribe, carry out a study to  
6 determine the availability and suitability of water resources  
7 within the Sells Papago Reservation but outside the Tucson  
8 Active Management Area and that part of the Upper Santa  
9 Cruz Basin not within that Area", and

7 WHEREAS, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) has been appropriated in FY 1985  
8 to enable the Secretary of the Interior to commence this study; and

9 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has not as of this date submitted a request to the  
10 Secretary of the Interior to carry out any study of the availability  
11 and suitability of water resources within the Sells Papago Reservation;  
12 and

13 WHEREAS, It is necessary that the District Councils and Tribal Council have  
14 available to them all previous studies, map data and other material  
15 relating to surface and groundwater within the Sells Papago Reservation;  
16 and

17 WHEREAS, It would be beneficial to the Districts and the Tribe if, based upon a  
18 compilation of existing data and maps and other materials relating to  
19 ground and surface water within the Sells Papago Reservation, a logical  
20 and hydrologically feasible approach to study the Reservation's known  
21 water basins and surface waters was prepared for review and approval by  
22 the Tribal Council; and

23 WHEREAS, It would be in the best interest of the eleven Districts of the Papago  
24 Reservation if a water management committee was established with each  
25 District having a representative serving thereon to work with the  
26 Chairman and/or Vice-Chairman to carry out the intent and purposes of  
27 this resolution.

28 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Tribal  
29 Advisors are hereby authorized to negotiate a 638 contract to locate,  
30 acquire and compile all available studies, maps, data and other material  
31 relating to surface and groundwater within the Sells Papago Reservation  
32 and, without entering upon any land within any district, prepare a


1 logical and hydrological approach to study the Reservation's known  
2 water basins and surface water and upon completion submit all studies,  
3 maps, data and other material, including a recommended approach to  
4 study to this Tribal Council for review, approval and disposition.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a water management committee is hereby established  
6 with each District Council to select a District member to serve thereon.  
7 It shall be the duty of this committee to work with the Chairman and/or  
8 Vice-Chairman to carry out the intent and purposes of this Resolution.


9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer are hereby  
10 authorized to enter into and execute all necessary contracts, sub-  
11 contracts and any other documents and instruments necessary to carry  
12 out the purpose and intent of this resolution.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd  
14 day of January, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
15 of 1,333.0 for; -0- against; 107.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant  
16 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (h)  
17 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,  
18 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
19 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
20 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
21 Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the  
22 Papago Council.
