

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Acceptance of proposed changes in Law and Order Code)

RES. NO. 200-85

1 WHEREAS, The Law and Order Committee has recommended changes to the proposed
2 draft of the Criminal Code; and

3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has considered and finds the recommended changes to
4 be in the best interest of the Tribe;

5 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does approve and
6 accept the recommended changes to the proposed criminal code to read
7 such changes to be reflected in the final draft:


8 Chapter 3, Section 3.8, Abuse of Religious Sites, Shrines and objects:
9 add "Burial sites".

10 Chapter 4, Section 4.13, Unlawful Cutting of a fence:
11 add "individual or private fences and corrals".


12 Chapter 14, Section 14.1 Misuse of a Weapon/and or Dangerous instrument
13 add:
14 15 years and 18 years.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
16 day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
18 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section (f); (h); (l); and (m) of
19 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
20 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
