

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Adoption into Tribal Membership)

RES. NO. 203-85

1 WHEREAS, GARCIA, Ernestine; GARCIA, Olsa; BIAS, Anna M. (Cervantes); GARCIA,
2 Marylou S. (Cervantes); CERVANTES, Lucia M.; and CHOYGUHA, Julia have
3 made application for adoption into Tribal membership pursuant to
4 Section 2 of Article II of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe; and
5 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed their respective applications,
6 has made a final determination that they are 1-1/2 degree or more of
7 Papago Indian Blood, and have made a recommendation to the Papago
8 Council that their applications be approved, all in accordance with
9 the provisions with the Papago Enrollment Ordinance; and
10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation of the Enrollment
11 Committee and the evidence submitted in support of the individual
12 applications.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the applications for

18 Papago Tribe.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
20 day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1386.5 for; -0- against; 53.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Article II and Article V, Section 2
23 (f) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Sec-
retary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the
Papago Council
