

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(FY-85 Head Start Grant-Program Improvement)

RES. NO. 204-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has consistently supported the Head Start Program  
2 providing comprehensive health, educational, nutritional, social and  
3 other services to preschool children and their families; and

4 WHEREAS, The Head Start Program has been successfully operated through the  
5 Early Childhood Head Start department and has served many young  
6 Papago Children; and

7  
8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is desirous of continuing this program for the  
9 benefit of its young members; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has previously applied for, and received funding to  
11 operate the Head Start Program from the Department of Health and  
12 Human Services, Head Start Bureau; and

13 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services has appropriated a por-  
14 tion of the FY 1985 increase for Head Start to be used for program  
15 improvement on a one-time basis to purchase needed equipment or  
16 services; and

18 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the proposed application and finds  
19 the same to be of benefit to the Head Start Program;


20 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
21 approve the proposed supplemental application in the amount of  
22 \$42,256.00 for Head Start Program improvement; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,  
25 Francisco Jose, Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the  
26 Papago Council are authorized to negotiate and execute any and all  
27 contracts, amendments and documents necessary to secure funding for  
28 the continued operation of the Head Start Program.

29 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th  
30 day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
31 1140.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
32 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) (f) and (k) of Article V  
of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary

1 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
2 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
3 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
the Papago Council.
