

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(FY-86 Title XX Grant-Child Day Care)

RES. NO. 206-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has consistently supported the nurturment of its  
2 young members by providing for their welfare through various  
3 programs and services designed to meet their special needs;

4 WHEREAS, The Child Day Care services program has been successfully operated  
5 through the Early Childhood department and has served many young  
6 Papago children; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is desirous of continuing this program for the  
8 benefit of its young members; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has previously applied for, and received funding to  
10 operate the Child Day Care service program from the Department of  
11 Economic Security, Block Grant Administration, Title XX; and


12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the proposed contract and finds the  
13 same to be of benefit to the Child Day Care services program;

14 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
15 approve the proposed Contract for Title XX services;

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,  
17 Francisco Jose, Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the  
18 Papago Council are authorized to negotiate and execute any and all  
19 contracts, amendments and documents necessary to secure funding for  
20 the continued operation of the Day Care Program.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th  
22 day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
23 1140.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
24 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) (f) and (k) of Article V  
25 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
26 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
27 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
28 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
29 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
30 the Papago Council.
