


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Chukut Kuk District Budget Amendment FY 85)


1 WHEREAS, The Chukut Kuk District Council did by Resolution approve an additional  
2 sum of funds to complete the San Miguel Community project; and  
3 WHEREAS, A Contract with E. K. Landscapers has been signed by the District  
4 Chairman committing the District to \$62,500.00 for the project; and  
5 WHEREAS, The Chukut Kuk District has sufficient funds in its IIM Account to  
6 cover the additional cost for completion of the project;  
7 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby and  
8 authorize the Chukut Kuk District to amend its FY 85 Budget in the  
9 amount of \$23,500.00 to be expended in accordance with the proposed  
10 use of completing San Miguel Community Project. This amendment to  
11 the FY 85 Chukut Kuk District brings the total amount from \$363,521.00  
12 + \$23,500.00 to \$387,021.00..

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd  
14 day of January, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
15 of 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to  
16 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (a)  
17 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
18 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
19 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
20 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of  
21 its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review  
22 by the Secretary of the Interior.


