1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has allocated \$21,981.73 of federal revenue sharing  
2 funds to the Schuk Toak District; and


3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has heard evidence concerning the use of such funds

5 the attached resolution of the District Council of the Schuk Toak

9 same.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the \$21,981.73 of  
11 federal revenue sharing funds allocated to the Schuk Toak District be  
12 distributed in accordance with the requests presented at the public  
13 hearing and that it does hereby approve the attached 1985 revenue  
14 sharing budget of the Schuk Toak District and authorize expenditures  
15 in accordance therewith.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th  
18 day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
19 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the  
20 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of  
21 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified  
22 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the  
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of  
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
Council.
