

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Alcoholism, Prevention, Education and Rehabilitation Program)

RES. NO. 213-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has successfully operated an Alcoholism Program for
2 its people; and

3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council recognizes that Alcoholism is one of the most
4 pressing and chronic health problems confronting the Papago people;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, The Papago Alcoholism Program intends to continue providing services
7 to eligible clients by structuring its program into three areas:
8 youth services, adult services and operation of a Rehabilitation
9 Center; and

10 WHEREAS, 25 CFR 271.20 require that all proposals to recontract under P. L.
11 93-638 regulations be submitted for approval at least 120 days prior
12 to the contract termination; and

13 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe proposes to continue the Papago Alcoholism program
14 during FY'86 by contracting for P. L. 93-638 funds;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does request the
16 Public Health Service, Indian Health Service to contract with the
17 Papago Tribe pursuant to P. L. 93-638 and its regulations and
18 procedures for the operation of a Papago Alcoholism Prevention,
19 Education and Rehabilitation Program; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract will be from
21 October 01, 1985 through September 30, 1986 unless extended by
22 mutual agreement of both contracting parties;

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event this contract is not in effect on
24 October 01, 1985, the existing FY'85 contract will be continued until
25 such time as the FY'86 contract is in effect;

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Papago Tribe will not
27 fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are
28 still being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by
29 Indian Health Services;

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice-
31 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized and

directed to negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments and documents necessary for the implementation of the contract.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
