

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Tabling of Papago Trading Post Lease)

RES. NO. 215-85

1 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council has recommended to the Papago Council to
2 approve and execute a business lease between the Papago Tribe and the
3 Papago Trading Post; and

4 WHEREAS, Several Council representatives have expressed concern about certain
5 conditions at the business location which should be addressed before
6 the five year lease is approved; and


7 WHEREAS, To avoid any unnecessary interference in the day to day operations of
8 the Papago Trading Post an extension of the current lease under which
9 the Papago Trading Post is operating is necessary pending the outcome
10 of the discussions with Randy Graham, proprietor of the Papago Trading
11 Post concerning the issues raised by the Papago Council; and

12 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is desirous of hearing from Mr. Graham concerning
13 the matters raised by the several Council representatives;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby grant
15 one month's extension of the existing lease between the Papago Tribe
16 and the Papago Trading Post pending the outcome of discussions between
17 the Papago Council and Mr. Graham, proprietor, and, that Mr. Graham be
18 invited to attend the May, 1985 Council meeting to answer questions
19 and provide information on the issues raised by the Papago Council.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 17th
21 day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
22 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
23 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a); (f); (h); and (e) of
24 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
