NO. 216-85 WHEREAS, Section 303 (b) (a) of Title III of Public Law 97-293 (Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982) reads as follows: "In order to encourage the Papago Tribe to develop sources of water on the Sells Papago Reservation, the Secretary shall, if so requested by the Tribe, carry out a study to determine the availability and suitability of water resources within the Sells Papago Reservation but outside the Tucson Active Management Area and that part of the Upper Santa Cruz Basin not within the Area"; and WHEREAS, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) has been appropriated in FY 1985 to enable the Secretary of the Interior to commence this study; and WHEREAS, H. R. 5969 and S. 2855 were introduced in the U. S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate, respectively, (98th Congress, 2nd Session) and are in the process of being redrafted and reintroduced in the U.S. House and Senate within the next few months; and WHEREAS, The new water settlement bill for the Chui-Chu Area of the Sif Oidak District will have a section authorizing and directing the Secretary to construct a multi-purpose dam at Silver Reef and divert water for agricultural, recreational and other uses, if such a dam is considered practicable and feasible; and WHEREAS, The new water settlement bill for the Chui-Chu Area of the Sif Oidak District will have another section transferring to the Papago Tribe all water rights attached to the public lands in the South Vekol Water Basin; and WHEREAS, It is critical that a thorough study be made, as soon as possible, regarding the feasibility of constructing a multi-purpose day at Silver Reef and the quantity, quality and usability of water located in South Vekol Basin so as to expedite the progress of the new water settlement bill of the Chui-Chu Area of the Sif Oidak District; and WHEREAS, The One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) that has been appropriated in FY 1985 is available to pay for these studies. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Tribal advisors are hereby authorized to negotiate a 638 contract to commence a study of the feasibility of constructing a multi-purpose dam at
