


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Supporting the Sif Oidak District Resolution No. 05-85)

RES. NO. 217-85

1 WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District Council by Resolution 05-85 advised the Papago
2 Council of problems concerning the removal of Sand and Gravel by prime
3 contractors or sub-contractors constructing projects within the
4 District without compensation or permission by the District; and
5 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 13-82 authorizes District Councils to regulate the
6 mining or removal of sand and gravel by entering into agreements with
7 prospective users with all proceeds derived from the sale thereof to
8 be deposited into the District's IIM Account;
9 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs and other Federal and State agencies have
10 allowed prime contractors and sub-contractors to mine or remove sand
11 and gravel without District permission or compensation; and
12 WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District Council is requesting compensation based on
13 fair market value of the sand and gravel in all recent projects under-
14 taken for the Papago Tribe through contracts issued by the Bureau of
15 Indian Affairs and for other Federal Agencies, in particular the road
16 resurfacing and future road projects within the District;
17 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is supportive of the Sif Oidak District's position
18 and urges cooperation by the respective Federal agencies;
19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby direct
20 and authorize the Bureau of Indian Affairs and/or other Federal and
21 State agencies proposing to construct or undertake projects requiring
22 the use of sand and gravel to enter into written agreements with the
23 District Council based on negotiated agreements concerning the value of
24 sand and gravel to be mined or removed for such projects; and
25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that past or recent construction
26 projects for which no compensation was given to the District Council
27 be negotiated and compensation be paid to the District Council based
28 on the fair market value of the sand and gravel removed without the
29 District Council's authorization.
30 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 17th
31 day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
32 1325.5 for; -0- against; 114.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a); (c); (d); (f); and (h)
of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as

1 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
2 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
3 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
by the Papago Council.
