

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Rejection of membership application
of SAMUEL V. ARMENTA)

RES. NO. 239-85

1 WHEREAS, An application for enrollment as a member of the Papago Tribe of the
2 the Papago Reservation has been filed by or on behalf of SAMUEL V.
3 ARMENTA ("applicant"), namely application No. No District filed on
4 the 26TH day of May, 1976; and

5 WHEREAS, The Enrollment Committee has reviewed the application and has recom-
6 mended that the application be denied because the applicant failed
7 to establish the following membership requirement(s): PAPAGO
8 CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP - SECTION (1A) & (1B);
9 and

11 WHEREAS, The application has come on for hearing before this Council; and

12 WHEREAS, The Enrollment Committee did serve written notice of its recommen-
13 dation to reject the application and of this hearing, as required by
14 Section 2, Article VI of the Papago Enrollment Ordinance, upon the
15 person who filed the application and such person was not present at
16 this hearing; and

18 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed all of the evidence presented and
19 from such evidence finds that the applicant has failed to establish
20 the foregoing membership requirement(s).

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
22 determine that the application SAMUEL V. ARMENTA for enrollment as
23 a member of the Papago Tribe is hereby rejected.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Papago Council shall issue a
26 certificate of Final Determination of Rejection and that the En-
27 rollment Committee serve Notice of Rejection of the application in
28 accordance with the provisions of Section 1 and 2, Article VIII of
29 of the Papago Enrollment Ordinance.

30 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th
31 day of April, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
32 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent; pursuant to the

1 authority vested in the Papago Council by Article II and Section 2 (f) of
2 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
3 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
4 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
5 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
6 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
7 its enactment by the Papago Council.
