

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Needs Assessment on Santa Rosa Boarding School)

RES. NO. 26-85

1 WHEREAS, Information has been provided to the Papago Council concerning the  
2 funding problems being experienced by the Santa Rosa Boarding School;

3 WHEREAS, This funding crisis has resulted in reduction-in-force actions by the  
4 Santa Rosa Boarding School Board to attempt to save operations and  
5 maintenance funds for the operations of the school;

6 WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the Papago Council to determine how severe  
7 this funding crisis is and to plan a course of action to alleviate  
8 this situation;


9 WHEREAS, An assessment of the total needs of the Santa Rosa Boarding must be  
10 conducted to determine what impacts this funding crisis has had and  
11 will have on employees, both teachers and classified, students and the  
12 community now and in the future if no remedial actions are taken;

13 WHEREAS, The Education Director and the Education Committee are the appropriate  
14 persons to conduct this assessment.


15 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby direct  
16 the Education Director and the Education Committee to conduct a needs  
17 assessment on the Santa Rosa Boarding School taking into consideration  
18 the funding crisis and its impact on the school's community of teachers,  
19 employees, students and parents;

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th  
21 day of February, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
22 of 1,241.0 for; 121.0 against; 78.0 not voting; -0- absent, pursuant to the  
23 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f), (h) and (k) of  
24 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by  
the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment  
by the Papago Council.
