8		committee with sole responsibility to negotiate, scrutinize and
9		execute purchase of land found to be useful to the needs of a
10		particular District or community of the Papago Tribe;
11	WHEREAS,	The Papago Council is empowered by the Constitution to establish
12		committees and to prescribe their duties and appoint members; and
13	WHEREAS,	It is the desire of the Papago Council to delegate this authority to
14		the Executive Office to establish a Land Acquisition Committee with
15		the responsibility to oversee and execute any future land purchases
16		or transfers in the best interest of the Papago Tribe;
17	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
18		authorize and direct the Executive Office to establish a Land
19		Acquisition Committee and appoint members to this Committee, and,
20		to prescribe their duties in accordance with this resolution.
