## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Support of Sif Oidak District Reso. No. 07-85)

RES. NO. 335-85

WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District Council has expressed by Resolution its intent on being actively involved in future home improvement and building construction projects through the selection on process used to select contractors bidding for the particular project; and

WHEREAS, There is federal regulation and authority supporting the District Council's involvement in this process; and

WHEREAS, Active District involvement will help deter any future faulty construction and provide a recourse for the aggrieved or affected person to appeal to the District Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby support the Sif Oidak District Council's efforts to control and actively participate in the selection of contractors bidding for the many projects of home improvement and building expected to take place within the Sif Oidak District in accordance with applicable federal regulations.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>08th</u> day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,440.0</u> for; <u>-0-</u> against; <u>-0-</u> not voting; and <u>01</u> absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
