

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Support of Sif Oidak District Reso. No. 07-85)

1 WHEREAS, The Sif Oidak District Council has expressed by Resolution its intent
2 on being actively involved in future home improvement and building
3 construction projects through the selection on process used to select
4 contractors bidding for the particular project; and



6 WHEREAS, There is federal regulation and authority supporting the District
7 Council's involvement in this process; and

8 WHEREAS, Active District involvement will help deter any future faulty
9 construction and provide a recourse for the aggrieved or affected
10 person to appeal to the District Council;


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
12 support the Sif Oidak District Council's efforts to control and actively
13 participate in the selection of contractors bidding for the many projects
14 of home improvement and building expected to take place within the Sif
15 Oidak District in accordance with applicable federal regulations.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 08th
18 day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
20 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) of Article
21 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
22 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
