5		acres which have already been fully assigned to members of the com-
7		munity, and additional lands are necessary as homesites for other
8		community members presently without land assignments; and
9	WHEREAS,	Mr. Justin LaFont, owner of approximately 22.796 acres of land lying
10		adjacent to Florence Village, has offered to sell such land for
11		\$40,000.00; and
12	WHEDEAS	The Gu Achi District Council has urged the prompt acquisition of the

14		land from Mr. LaFont and has appropriated \$20,000.00 of District funds
15		for such acquisition, provided the Papago Council approves thereof and
16		appropriates the balance of funds necessary to purchase the land; and
17	WHEREAS,	The Papago Council has determined that the proposed purchase price is
18		reasonable and that there is a great need for additional land to
19		accommodate members of the Florence Village community for whom there
20		is no land on which homesite assignments can be made.

22		authorize and direct the Chairman, Attorneys and appropriate officers
24		of the Papago Tribe to negotiate on behalf of the Papago Tribe for

26		Florence Village for a purchase price of approximately \$40,000.00,
27		conditioned upon approval of such acquisition and acceptance of the
28		land by the Secretary of the Interior in trust and as an addition

31		to be appropriated a sum not to exceed \$25,000.00 as part purchase
