

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Computer Proposal)

RES. NO. 340-85

1 WHEREAS, Section 104 (a) of P.L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds
2 for the purpose of strengthening and improvement of tribal government
3 and;

4 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$247,800.00 of FY 85 funds
5 for such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and

6
7 WHEREAS, There is a balance of \$43,562.77 under Self Determination funds. The
8 Tribe did submit a request on March 21, 1985 to reallocate funds in
9 the amount of \$55,500.00 from Aide to Tribal Government to Self
10 Determination funds to \$303,300.00. Any remaining balance of grant
11 funds will be budgeted for indirect cost.


12 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its tribal
13 government and management by acquiring a computer system for ac-
14 counting and enrollment functions in the amount of \$82,000.00.

16 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence June
17 01, 1985 and end May 31, 1986.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
19 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby authorized to ne-
20 gotiate and sign amendments and extensions to such grant.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 08th
22 day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
23 1,379.0 for; -0- against; 61.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
24 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and Section 3 (a)
25 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
26 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
27 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date
of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior.
