

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Establishment of Tribal Standing Committee)

RES. NO. 344-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 332-85 halt any further
2 developments with the Santa Cruz Properties until certain conditions
3 were complied with; and

4 WHEREAS, It would be to the interests of the Papago Tribe to establish a
5 committee charged with the responsibility to represent the Tribe's
6 interest in any negotiations with Santa Cruz Properties, Inc.;


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8 WHEREAS, A representative committee will consist of Chairman/Chairwomen of all
9 the Papago Councils standing committees, boards and commissions; and

10 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby appoint
11 the following individuals to a Committee to work on developments and
12 negotiations concerning the proposed development at San Xavier by the
13 Santa Cruz Properties, Inc.; and further that this Committee will
14 develop such procedures and guidelines to aid in its task.

32 679.0 for; 538.5 against; 222.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f) and (h) of
Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
