

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Scheduled meeting in June with Standing Committee and Allottees)

RES. NO. 345-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 344-85 establish a Committee
2 consisting of all persons chairing Tribal Committees, Boards and
3 Commissions to review and negotiate the terms and conditions of a
4 lease with Santa Cruz Properties, Inc.;



6 WHEREAS, It is necessary to bring this Committee together with the Papago
7 Council and individual allottees whose lands are affected by the
8 lease at a Council meeting to discuss and develop goals and object-
9 tives to pursue in the negotiation process;

10 WHEREAS, June 7, 1985 has been proposed as the date for this meeting;


11 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby appoint
12 June 7, 1985 as the date for a meeting of the Papago Council with in-
13 dividual allottees whose lands are affected by the lease, and the
14 Chairpersons appointed to sit as members of the negotiating Committee.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 09th
17 day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 1387.5 for; -0- against; 52.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f), (h) and (i) of
20 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
21 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by
the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
by the Papago Council.
