11	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby appoint

14	dividual allottees whose lands are affected by the lease, and the						
15	Chairpersons appointed to sit as members of the negotiating Committee.						
16	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>09th</u> day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1387.5</u> for; <u>-0-</u> against; <u>52.5</u> not voting; and <u>01</u> absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f), (h) and (i) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
