

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Adoption into Tribal Membership)

RES. NO. 347-85

1 WHEREAS, SALAZAR, Manuela; SANRIQUES, Ygnacio G., Sr.; have made application
2 for adoption into Tribal membership pursuant to Section 2 of Article
3 II of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe; and

4 WHEREAS, The Enrollment Committee has reviewed their respective applications,
5 has made a final determination that they are 1 - 1/2 degree or more
6 of Papago Indian blood, and have made a recommendation to the Papago
7 Council that their applications be approved, all in accordance with
8 the provisions with the Papago Enrollment Ordinance; and

9 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation of the Enrollment
10 Committee and the evidence submitted in support of the individual
11 applications.


12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the applications for
13 adoptions filed by:

16 are hereby approved and they are hereby adopted into membership of the
17 Papago Tribe.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 09th
19 day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1,38.5 for; -0- against; 101.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
21 authority vested in the Papago Council by Article II and Article V, Section 2
22 (f) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as ~~amended~~
23 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
24 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
25 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
26 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
27 its enactment by the Papago Council.
