

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Papago Trading Post Lease)

RES. NO. 350-85

1 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council did on March 28, 1985 approve terms and
2 conditions for a lease between the Papago Trading Post and the Papago
3 Tribe; and


4 WHEREAS, The Sells District Council has determined that it would be in the
5 best interests of the Sells District to renew the lease existing
6 between the Papago Trading Post and the Papago Tribe; and

8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has the authority pursuant to Article V, Section
9 3 (e) to regulate and license non-members desiring to conduct
10 business on the Papago Reservation;

11 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
12 approve the terms and conditions of the attached lease between the
13 Papago Tribe and the Papago Trading Post and hereby authorizes the
14 Chairman, Josiah Moore, or the Vice-Chairman, Francisco Jose, or
15 Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer to execute any and all documents and any
16 amendments thereto concerning aforementioned lease between the Papago
17 Tribe and the Papago Trading Post.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th
20 day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
22 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and 3 (e) of
23 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
24 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is
subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
