

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(To prohibit Southwest American Indian Movement to
conduct Conference at Baboquivari Mountain Park)

RES. NO. 351-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has learned that the Baboquivari District Council
2 on May 8, at an emergency session, voted to allow the Southwest
3 American Indian Movement to conduct a leadership and spiritual me-
4 morial conference at Baboquivari Park; and

5 WHEREAS, The Southwest American Indian Movement had planned to conduct this
6 conference as early as April 4, 1985 but did not approach the
7 Baboquivari District Council until they were told that prior District
8 Council approval was required for this type of meeting in accordance
9 with Ordinance 04-82; and

10 WHEREAS, Members of the Southwest American Indian Movement are aware of the
11 requirements but failed to comply until they were told they could
12 not hold the conference;

13 WHEREAS, The topics to be discussed during this conference are issues currently
14 being considered by the Papago Tribe but no invitation was extended to
15 the Tribe to obtain their official view or position; and

16 WHEREAS, It is the belief of the Papago Council that the Baboquivari District
17 Council had no choice but to approve having heard from leaders of the
18 Southwest American Indian Movement that non-members were traveling to
19 the Papago Reservation and publicity announcing the conference had
20 already been printed;

21 WHEREAS, It is in the interests of all Districts of the Papago Reservation for
22 the Papago Council to deny the Southwest American Indian Movement to
23 conduct their conference at Baboquivari Mountain Park on May 10, 11,
24 and 12, 1985;

25 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
26 overrule the decision of the Baboquivari District Council to allow the
27 Southwest American Indian Movement to conduct a leadership and
28 spiritual memorial conference on May 10, 11, and 12, 1985 at the
29 Baboquivari Mountain Park; and


30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that in accordance with Ordinance
31 No. 02-82; 03-83 and 04-82 the Southwest American Indian Movement is
32 not allowed to hold the conference because they did not get prior

approval from the District Council in a timely manner even though they had planned all along to hold the conference at Baboquivari Mountain Park as publicized on the posters.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 09th day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,134.5 for; -0- against; 305.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f); (m), and Section 3 (c) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
