

THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION
(Request for transfer of BIA Employee)

RES. NO. 356-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has learned that the Assistant Secretary of Indian
2 Affairs, upon the advice and recommendation of the Director of Social
3 Services, Dr. Ed Brown, will decide to reject the Papago Tribe's
4 appeal protesting the reduction of the Tribe's FY 85 Human Services
5 contract for monitoring costs; and

6
7 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has consistently rejected the Bureau of Indian
8 Affairs position concerning monitoring and technical assistance
9 charges on the grounds that Congress specifically prohibited the
10 Bureau of Indian Affairs from reducing grants or contracts for
11 monitoring or technical assistance costs and because it was contrary
12 to, and a violation of P. L. 93-638;

13 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been advised of the offer by the Social Services
14 Director in Washington, D.C. whereby the Papago Tribe would agree to
15 return of only \$19,650, such amount reflecting half of the total re-
16 tained by the Bureau for monitoring costs, in effect compromising the
17 original position taken by the Papago Tribe demanding that the full
18 amount retained by the Bureau of Indian Affairs be restored to the
19 Human Service Contract;

21 WHEREAS, The Director further offered to the Papago Tribe an agreement that half
22 of the monitoring costs would be paid by the Bureau of Indian Affairs
23 and half by the Papago Tribe such amount to be distributed across the
24 board among all of the Tribe's 638 contracts and grants during FY 86
25 and 87; and

27 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has not received competent or efficient services from
28 the 638 Coordinator, Mr. Bill Wilson, and believes it would be in the
29 interests of the Tribe to request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to
30 transfer Mr. Wilson immediately; and

32 WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes it would prevail on the merits if an appeal
is made to the Board of Indian Appeals upon receipt of the decision;


1 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that it does hereby confirm
2 its original position protesting the action of the Phoenix Area Office
3 to retain monitoring costs thereby reducing the Human Service Contract
4 by \$39,300.00 in order to pay salary and office expenses for Mr. Bill
5 Wilson, 638 Coordinator; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the decision of the Papago Council, in
8 accordance with Article V, Section 3 (f) of the Papago Constitution,
9 to request the immediate transfer of the 638 Coordinator, Mr. Bill
10 Wilson; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs restore the full
12 amount taken at the beginning of the fiscal year 1985 to the Human
13 Services contract and that upon receipt of the decision by the
14 Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs that an appeal be filed with the
15 Board of Indian Appeals;

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
18 day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 1440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
20 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and 3 (a), (f)
21 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
22 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as
of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and
is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
