

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Tribal Housing Inventory)

RES. NO. 357-85

1 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has proposed a housing inventory for the
2 purpose of distributing HIP funds in accordance with tribal housing
3 needs projected in a "Tribal Plan for Use of HIP Funds";

4 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has advised the Papago Tribe of the
5 intent to withhold HIP contracts and recontracts for FY 86 pending
6 direction from Congress on procedural changes to the HIP program; and

8 WHEREAS, The Papago Council agrees that a housing inventory is necessary to
9 justify and efficiently expend HIP funds but considers the present
10 method and survey instrument inadequate because it does not accu-
11 rately reflect the true housing needs of the Papago Tribe; and

12 WHEREAS, The survey form will not be recognized as accurate or used in a
13 subsequent assessment and the preliminary figures obtained as a
14 result of this survey instrument are submitted under strong protest;


17 WHEREAS, The figures submitted are considered by the Papago Council to be pre-
18 liminary estimates of housing needs and submitted as preliminary
19 figures; and

20 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe will conduct a reassessment of the housing needs
21 and upon completion of such reassessment submit results to the Bureau
22 of Indian Affairs as final data;


24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it has reviewed the
25 results compiled in response to the housing inventory required by the
26 Bureau of Indian Affairs and finds such figures to be preliminary in
27 nature as they do not accurately reflect the true state of housing
28 needs of the Papago Tribe, and approves the submission of such
29 figures only as preliminary effort; and that the Papago Tribe will
30 conduct a subsequent housing needs assessment and submit final data
31 upon completion of such an assessment.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
2 day of May, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
3 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
4 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and (h) of
5 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
6 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
7 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
8 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
9 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
10 its enactment by the Papago Council.
