(BIA/Tribal Budget Priorities FY-1987)

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs has submitted to the  
2 Papago Council the projected funding amounts for FY-1987; and

3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is required to establish Agency program  
4 priorities and set program funding and staffing levels by using the  
5 Decision Ranking chart; and

7 WHEREAS, The Decision Ranking Chart allows the Papago Tribe to participate  
8 in the Federal Budget process and to allocate resources in the most  
9 cost efficient manner which will provide maximum services and  
10 benefits for its members; and





Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
