

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Rescheduled meeting for June 7 to July 15, 1985  
with Standing Committees and Allottees)

RES. No. 360-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did halt any further developments on the proposed  
2 Santa Cruz Development project at San Xavier; and

3 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did set aside June 7, 1985 to hear from allottees  
4 who will be affected by this proposed development and the Committee  
5 established by the Papago Council on May 13, 1985;


6 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has learned that no notices were sent to any of the  
7 parties required to be at the meeting on June 7, 1985;

8 WHEREAS, It is the desire of the Papago Council to hold the meeting and to hear  
9 from allottees who will be affected by this proposed development and  
10 from the committee as to the development of the goals and objectives  
11 that will guide the Committee in its tasks as directed by Council;


12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
13 reschedule the meeting of June 7, 1985, between the Papago Council,  
14 affected allottees and the Committee membership to July 15, 1985 and  
15 directs that notices be issued to all interested parties in a timely  
16 manner to assure their presence at the meeting on July 15, 1985.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th day  
18 of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 921.0  
19 for; 388.5 against; 130.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the authority  
20 vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f) and (h) of Article V of the  
21 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by  
22 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the  
23 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
24 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of  
25 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago  
26 Council.
