

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(May 25, 1985, General Election)

RES. NO. 361-85

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe did on Saturday, May 25, 1985, have a General Election  
2 for the offices of Representatives and Alternates to the Papago  
3 Council, and for the offices of Representatives and Alternates to the  
4 District Councils; and

5  
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Election Board did issue and post its Certificates of  
7 Election Results in accordance with Section 4 (J) of Article VI of the  
8 Uniform Election Ordinance, certifying to the election of the  
9 candidates who received the highest number of votes for elective  
10 office; and

11 WHEREAS, Dewey I. Ortega did file an election contest with the Papago Election  
12 Board, contesting the election in the San Lucy District, and the Papago  
13 Election Board did, at a hearing held on June 3, 1985, determine that  
14 the election contest was without merit and should be dismissed; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, under Section 4 (M) of Article VI of the Uniform Election Ordinance, it  
17 is incumbent upon the Papago Council to issue Certificates of Election  
18 to the candidates who received the highest number of votes for each  
19 Council seat within 10 days after the Election Board has posted its  
20 Certificates of Election Results.

21 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Chairman and  
22 Secretary of the Papago Council are hereby authorized and directed on  
23 behalf of the Papago Council to execute and deliver a Certificate of  
24 Election to the following Persons elected from their respective  
25 Districts as Representatives and Alternates to the Papago Council, who  
26 shall hold offices for a term of four (4) years and until their  
27 successors are certified and seated, to wit:


