

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Direct Treasurer to identify source of funding for
Hiatit O'Odham FY 86 Budget)

RES. NO. 363-85

1 WHEREAS, The Hiatit O'Odham did present a proposal to the Budget & Finance
2 Committee proposing to establish an office to carry out goals and
3 objectives identified by the Hiatit O'Odham designed to resolve
4 certain membership and land problems; and

5
6 WHEREAS, The Budget & Finance Committee reviewed the proposal and determined
7 that the proposal should be presented for funding at the beginning of
8 the FY 86; and

9 WHEREAS, The Hiatit O'Odham believe their concerns and issues to be of vital
10 significance requiring the immediate attention of the Papago Council;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, The Papago Council is supportive of the goals and objectives of the
13 Hiatit O'Odham and find the establishment of an office to be within
14 the interests of the Papago Tribe;

16 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby support
17 the establishment of an office to carry out the tasks and objectives
18 identified by the Hiatit O'Odham and approves and authorizes an appro-
19 priation not to exceed \$65,000 to fund this office for FY 86 and from
20 that point to follow the budget process required of all tribal
21 programs.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
24 day of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
25 1105.5 for; 406.0 against; 128.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
26 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) of Article V of
27 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
28 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
