8 has made a final determination that they are 1 - 1/2 degree or more
9 of Papago Indian Blood, and have made a recommendation to the Papago
10 Council that their applications be approved, all in accordance with
11 the provisions with the Papago Enrollment Ordinance; and

12 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation of the Enrollment
13 Committee and the evidence submitted in support of the individual
14 applications.


15 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the applications for

27 day of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
28 1523.0 for; -0- against; 117.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
29 authority vested in the Papago Council by Article II and Article V, Section
30 2 (f) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amend-
31 ed, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
32 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enact-
ment by the Papago Council.
