Solicitation No. H54-R-5-6 and for the purpose for said contract the tribe does hereby adopt by reference the construction plans and specifications and such other documents, data, or other materials that maybe necessary or appropriate as published in said Solicitation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and other necessary Tribal Officials are hereby authorized to prepare, execute and submit to the proper Federal agencies applications, documents, data, contracts, plans and contracts necessary to initiate and finalize this road construction contract, to advertise for bids and to award a contract or contracts for such road construction and or improvements and to monitor and supervise said contract or contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that due to the fact that the Papago Tribe will be the contractor of this road construction contract, the Transaction Privilege Tax, Ordinance No. 03-81 will be inapplicable as to this project.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
