

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Cost of Living Allowance)

RES. NO. 375-85

1 WHEREAS, The Budget and Finance has reviewed proposed budgets for grants and
2 contracts funded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to P.L.
3 93-638; and
4

5 WHEREAS, These proposed budgets have included an increase in salaries for all
6 grant or contract funded employees, such increase reflecting a 2½%
7 cost of living adjustment; and


8 WHEREAS, The Budget and Finance did also review the Tribe's funding resources
9 and determined that sufficient funds will be available to allow all
10 tribally-funded programs the same 2½ cost of living adjustment;

11 WHEREAS, The adopted salary schedule provides for step increments of 2½%
12 bringing the proposed cost of living adjustment within the salary
13 schedule;

15 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that it does hereby approve
16 and authorize a two and one-half (2½) percent cost of living adjust-
17 ment for all tribal employees excluding the Mining Director, Chairman
18 and Vice-Chairman, whether funded by 638 or tribal funds
19 for Fiscal Year 86, moving all such employees one step on the present
20 salary schedule.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
23 day of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
24 1108.0 for; 473.5 against; 58.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
25 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the
26 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by
27 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
28 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
29 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
30 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
31 Council.
