5		grant or contract funded employees, such increase reflecting a 2½%

8	WHEREAS,	The Budget and Finance did also review the Tribe's funding resource
9		and determined that sufficient funds will be available to allow all
10		tribally-funded programs the same $2\frac{1}{2}$ cost of living adjustment;
11	WHEREAS,	The adopted salary schedule provides for step increments of $2\frac{1}{2}\%$
12		bringing the proposed cost of living adjustment within the salary

Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
