

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Amendment to Resolution No. 25-84 appointing
Ned Norris Jr. to the Law & Order Committee)

RES. NO. 37-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 25-84 appoint Ned Norris Jr.
2 to the Law & Order Committee for a specified term of three (3) years
3 and;

4 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 133-82 specify staggered term
5 appointments for periods of one (1), two (2), and three (3) years
6 commencing in October of 1982, and;


7 WHEREAS, The three (3) year appointment of Francisco Jose Jr. was vacated upon
8 his elected position as Vice-Chairman of the Papago Council and;

9 WHEREAS, It is the intent of the Papago Council to remain consistent with its
10 established staggered term of appointments, therefore the appointment
11 of Ned Norris Jr. should have been for the purpose of completing the
12 unexpired three (3) year term vacated by Francisco Jose Jr.

13 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby amends
14 Resolution No. 25-84 to the extent that it affects the appointment of
15 Ned Norris Jr. by appointing him to the Law & Order Committee for the
16 purpose of completing the unexpired three (3) year term vacated by
17 Francisco Jose Jr. or until October 1985.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 07th
19 day of February, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
20 of 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
21 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of
22 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
23 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
24 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
25 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
26 Council.
