14	WHEREAS, The Papago Council does desire to recontract for provisions of these						
15	services during 1986; and						
16	WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has reviewed and approved the contract.						
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize						
18	and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the Papago						
19	Tribe under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the						
20	provisions of services titled Early Childhood Education Program.						
2122	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize the						
23	Papago Tribe to enter into a multi-year contract with the Bureau of						
24	Indian Affairs pursuant to 25 CFR 271.52. The contract term shall						
25	commence on October 1, 1985 and end on September 30, 1988.						
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate programs						
27	from which contracts are requested herewith which have not been						
28	negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to the						
29	start of the funding year.						
30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice						
31	Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council is hereby

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thereto for the duration of the contracts.
