

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Early Childhood Program)

RES. NO. 384-85

1 WHEREAS, The Early Childhood Education Program of the Papago tribe has been and
2 still is an effective and necessary early educational process that is
3 extremely beneficial to the pre-school Papago Children; and
4

5 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has continuously designated that education of its
6 youth is its highest priority; and

7 WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs once again has failed to implement the
8 Mandate of P. L. 95-561 - And to secure necessary appropriations to
9 fund the Early Childhood Program; and

10 WHEREAS, Congress has directed the Bureau of Indian Affairs to establish a
11 formula for funding for early childhood education programs which
12 funding would continue annually;
13

14 WHEREAS, The Papago Council does desire to recontract for provisions of these
15 services during 1986; and

16 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council has reviewed and approved the contract.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize
18 and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the Papago
19 Tribe under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the
20 provisions of services titled Early Childhood Education Program.
21

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize the
23 Papago Tribe to enter into a multi-year contract with the Bureau of
24 Indian Affairs pursuant to 25 CFR 271.52. The contract term shall
25 commence on October 1, 1985 and end on September 30, 1988.


26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate programs
27 from which contracts are requested herewith which have not been
28 negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to the
29 start of the funding year.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice
32 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council is hereby


1 authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any amendments
2 thereto for the duration of the contracts.

4 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
5 day of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
6 1502.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 5 absent, pursuant to the
7 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (m) of Article
8 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
9 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
