(Appointment of Dewey Ortega, Larry Martinez
and Larry Garcia to the Law & Order Committee)

RES. NO. 38-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 133-82 appoint five (5)
2 committee members for staggered terms of one (1); two (2); and three
3 (3) years and;

4 WHEREAS, The two year appointments of Mr. Dewey Ortega and Mr. Larry Martinez
5 expired in October 1984 and;

6 WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 25-84 appoint Ms. Barbara
7 Frank (Davis) to the Law & Order Committee, for a term of one (1) year,
8 and said term will expire in February 1985 and;

9 WHEREAS, There now exists three vacancies to the Law & Order Committee for terms
10 of two - two (2) years and one - one (1) year and;


11 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe to fill the vacancies.

14 scribed herein:



22 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article
23 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.
