

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
FY-85 Head Start Grant  
(Training/Technical Assistance)

RES. NO. 388-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has consistently supported the Head Start program  
2 providing comprehensive health, educational, nutritional, social and  
3 other services to preschool children and their families; and

4 WHEREAS, The Head Start program has been successfully operated through the  
5 Early Childhood Head Start department and has served many young Papago  
6 children; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is desirous of continuing this program for the  
8 benefit of its young members; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has previously applied for, and received funding to  
10 operate the Head Start program from the Department of Health and Human  
11 Services, Head Start Bureau; and

12 WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has requested a proposal for Training and  
13 Technical Assistance funding in the amount of \$4,165.00, to help off-  
14 set per diem costs for staff to attend a combined Arizona Indian  
15 Head Start preservice workshop; and

16 WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts office has reviewed the proposed application  
17 and finds the same to be of benefit to the Head Start Program;


18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
19 approve the proposed application for Training and Technical Assistance  
20 funding to supplement the Head Start Program; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman;  
22 Francisco Jose, Vice-Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the  
23 Papago Council are authorized to negotiate and execute any and all  
24 contracts, amendments and documents necessary to secure funding for  
25 the continued operation of the Head Start Program.


26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
27 day of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
28 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the  
29 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (m) of Article  
30 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
31 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
32

1 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
2 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
3 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by  
4 the Papago Council.
