

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Wise Ones Elderly Program Title VI)

RES. NO. 389-85

1 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe has successfully operated a program of services of
2 the older tribal members through the office of the Wise Ones Elderly
3 Program; and

4 WHEREAS, Funding for the operation of the Wise Ones Elderly Program has been
5 possible in part by Article VI of the Older American's Act of 1965 as
6 amended; and

8 WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding of its
9 program for elderly by submitting a proposal to the Office of Human
10 Development Services, Administration on Aging; and

11 WHEREAS, The Wise Ones Elderly proposal will benefit elder members of the Tribe
12 by providing for their nutritional and other social and support
13 services;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
16 approve the proposal to the Office of Human Development for
17 continued funding of the Wise Ones Elderly Program to provide
18 services to qualified residents of the Papago Reservation.


19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence on
20 October 1, 1985 and end September 30, 1986.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Josiah Moore, Chairman,
22 Francisco Jose, Vice Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer are
23 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all contracts,
24 amendments and documents necessary to secure funding for the
25 continued operation of the Wise Ones Elderly Program.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
28 day of June, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
29 1502.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 5 absent, pursuant to the
30 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (f) and (e) of Article
31 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
32 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by
the Papago Council.


